

Inbound Monitor



The Inbound Monitor provides an overview of all current and planned goods receipts in external procurement and in-house production.

Business Needs

- No uniform entry point available for inbound processes
- No cross-departmental monitoring of inbound items
- Using multiple transactions (for example, MD04, ME2L, MIGO) increases communication time and costs.



Delivery Approach and Scope

- Overview of all current and planned goods receipts in external procurement (purchase orders, delivery schedule lines, advanced shipping notifications, purchase requisitions), and in-house production (production orders, process orders, planned orders)
- Processing of exceptions (delivery date in the past)
- Navigation to follow-up transactions such as MIGO to post items
- Visualization of exceptions: For example, delivery dates in the past
- Warehouse clerks can transfer and post inbound items



Value and Benefits

- Cross-departmental selection: Logisticians, planners, buyers, production supervisors, and warehouse clerks access one list of inbound items.
- Management gains a rapid overview of the current situation and future goods receipts, and can respond quickly in the event of bottlenecks.
