Introduction:

- ❑ BC-AL connects content management systems to SAP. It is a cross-application interface that provides SAP applications with archive functionality. This interface is based on HTTP and a SAP NetWeaver BAPI interface. This integration scenario is also available with SAP S/4HANA
- ❑ The mandatory part of the certification test covers the communication between the SAP system and a partner's content server a HTTP (Hyper Text Transfer Protocol) between application server – front-end and content server.
- ❑ BC-AL 7.20 is tested with the SAP Content Server HTTP interface version 4.5 or 4.6 and BC-AL 7.40 is tested with SAP Content Server HTTP interface version 4.7. Both certification scenarios are offered in parallel.
- ❑ These integration scenarios are also available with SAP S/4HANA as S/4-BC-AL 7.20 and S/4-BC-AL 7.40.

❑ SAP NetWeaver 7.0 / SAP S/4HANA 1511 onwards

BC-AL remains unchanged. AL-LOAD was introduced as an optional load test sequence and is offered as a separate certification. A bundling with BC-AL is not required.

The integration scenario release BC-AL 7.40 supports the most recent SAP Content Server HTTP interface version 4.7 and utilizes the extended security features of the SAP NetWeaver Application Server like scanning documents for active content. However it does not replace the integration scenario BC-AL 7.20. The previous versions of the SAP HTTP Content Server interface versions 4.5 and 4.6 are still supported and we expect many SAP customers to stay with these versions. 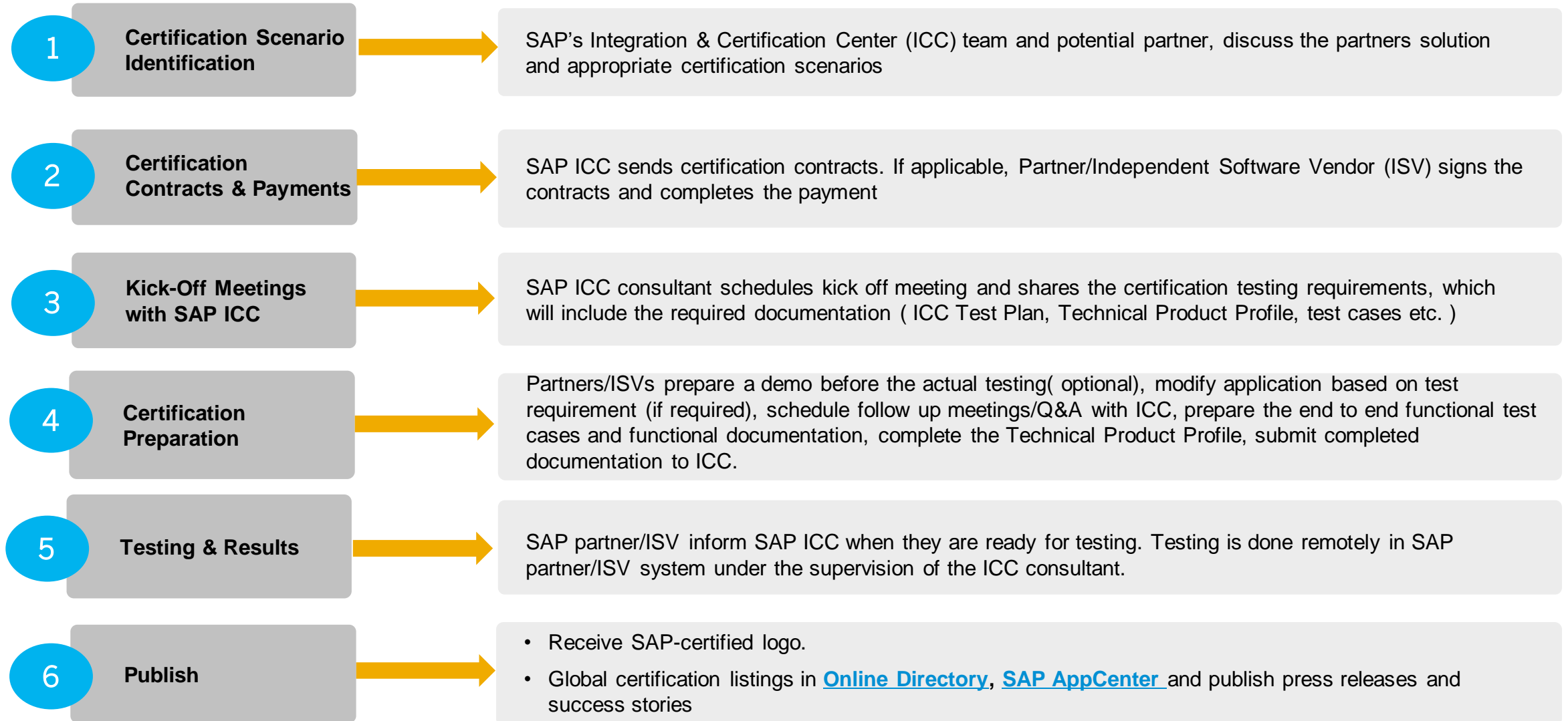
