# Introduction

- ❑ The SAP Integration and Certification Center provides an integration scenario for deploying Java applications on SAP NetWeaver. JAVA-EE-NW 7.5 certification scenario based on SAP NetWeaver 7.5 is available.
- ❑ In order to accompany the SAP Strategy of simplification and optimization, we have deprecated the previous certification scenarios called J2EE-DEP 7.0, J2EE-STD 7.0, JAVA-EE-ADV 7.1, JAVA-EE-STD 7.1, JAVA-EE-NW 7.2/7.3/7.4, since the integration scenario called JAVA-EE-NW 7.5 can technically replace those integration scenarios.
- ❑ During certification, SAP verifies that J2EE 1.4 / EE 5 specification compliant applications from independent software vendors can be deployed and run on the J2EE / EE 5 engine of the SAP NetWeaver 7.5 Java Application Server itself a fully J2EE / EE 5 compliant web application server. The SAP NetWeaver 7.5 Java Application Server is a robust and lean standard based platform that enables you to develop Java applications from scratch or migrate existing Java applications onto the SAP NetWeaver 7.5 Java Application Server.
- ❑ Deployment is regarded as the process of installing a J2EE 1.4 / EE 5 application in the form of an EAR file (Enterprise Application Archive file) on the SAP NetWeaver Java Application Server following deployment guidelines. For the 64 Bit SAP NetWeaver 7.5 Application Server Java™ EE 5 Edition the deployment must be conducted with a so called SCA file, ensuring that the successfully deployed software product which is equivalent to exactly one software component is SAP Solution Manager Ready. The successful deployment of the SCA file according to certification guidelines, followed by a functional test of the application itself, leads to SAP integration certification.
- ❑ For certification purposes, ISV's need to have an in house SAP NetWeaver 7.5 Java Application Server installed. At least "one" SAP NetWeaver developer user license must be purchased by the independent software vendor in order to meet SAP support requirements.


