The Challenge Scenario



The Challenge

You use the sum of the transport time and replenishment time from the deliver-the-plant as the planned delivery time. The resulting transfer order is scheduled using shipping scheduling based on the route. The receiving plant now has a requirement for which a transfer order request is created. The demand date for the transfer purchase requisition, which is now determined for the supplying plant, is as follows:

Requested date = Planned date (= Requested date) – Goods receiving time – Planned delivery time

and therefore too early for your own replenishment time. If you now reduce the planned delivery time to the pure transport time, the demand date in the deliver-the-plant would be correct, but the release date of the receiving plant might be too late to produce or produce the required material on the delivery side.

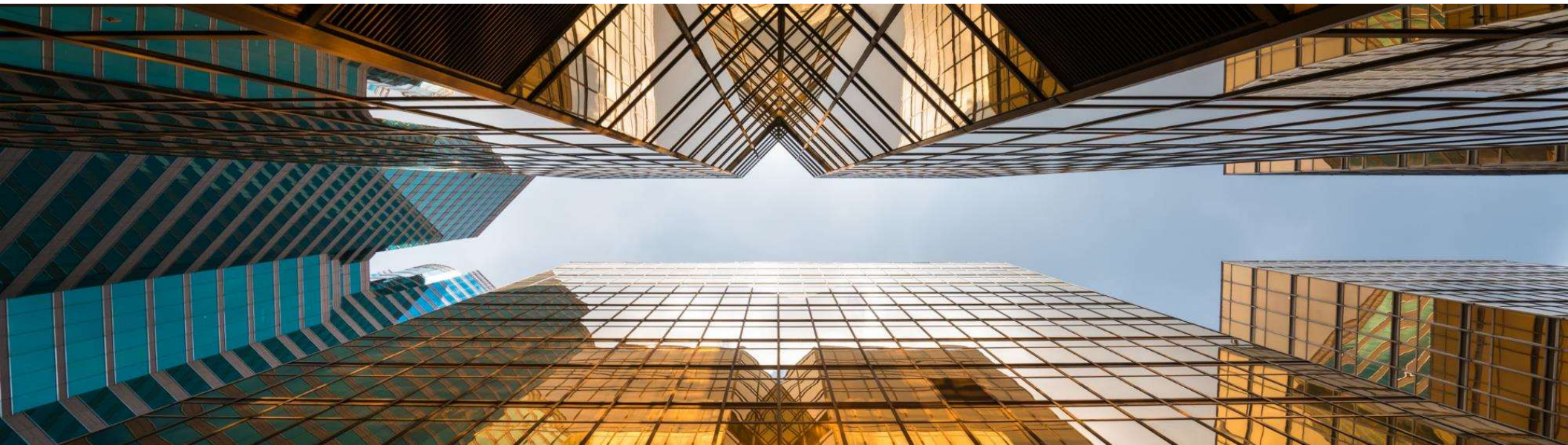
- **What are the prerequisites to install the monitor?**
Use of SAP ERP Materials Management
- **What are the advantages of the add-on EX-Works Stock Transfer (EXI)?**
Correct determination of the demand date in the supplying plant.
- **Is this add-on a modification?**
No, this is an add-on from SAP Consulting delivered by transport in its own namespace (/SAPLOM/...)
- **Is customizing necessary for the ability of the monitor to function?**
The transport contains all the function blocks required for the solution. Only the implementation of individual blocks is necessary in the customer system. Settings for Incoterms are made using Customizing.
- **How time-consuming is the implementation?**
The solution is delivered as a transport order and is thus in the customer's system landscape within one day
- **What is the cost of the monitor?**

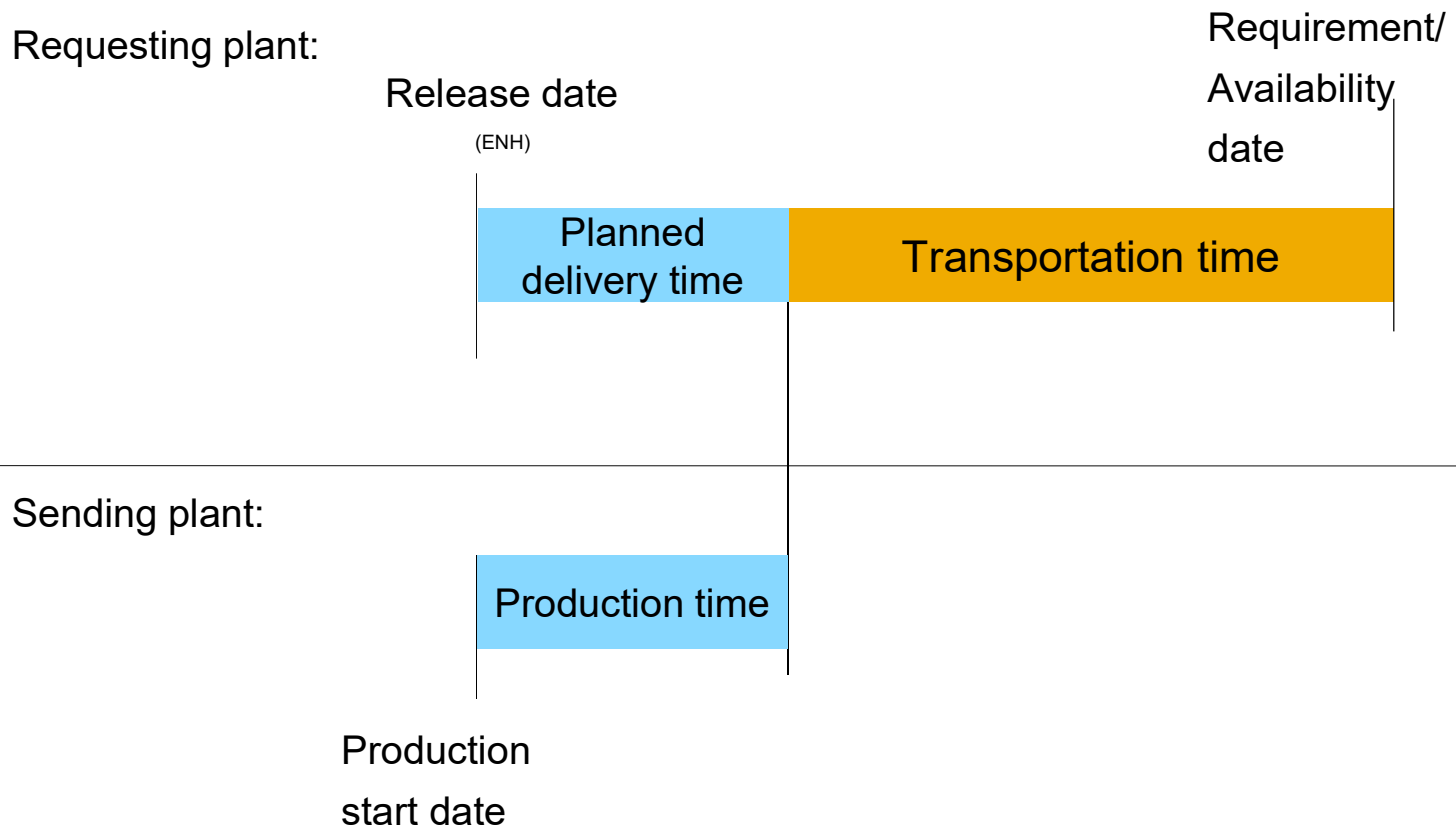

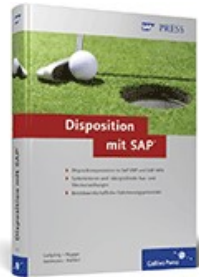

Differences to SAP-Standard

The add-on EX-Works (internal) stock transfer (EXI) offers the following advantages compared to the SAP standard in the Ex-Werks scenario:

- Correct determination of the demand date for the supplying plant
- Maintaining the release date to ensure availability on the delivery side
- Flexibility in transport time determination by BADI
