- ❑ SAP Workflow Management is part of Digital Process Automation in SAP Extension Suite of SAP Business Technology Platform. It combines Cloud applications for workflow, business rules and process visibility. It facilitates flexible adaptation and extending business processes based on changing business needs. These applications can connect to various systems, be it cloud-based or on-premise applications (SAP or non-SAP). Content packages are accelerators for doing this and enable business process experts to achieve process flexibility.
- ❑ Predefined, ready-to-use and prepackaged Workflow Management content is made available by SAP, which drastically reduces project lead times and lowers resource consumption significantly.


